We develop reports, briefs and submissions based on industry consultation and research to profile industry sectors and inform government on workforce development, education and training.

Workforce Training & Capability Building

We advocate for quality training to meet industry-specific needs and a skilled and flexible workforce. Engagement with industry stakeholders allows the Training Council to identify the skills and workforce development priorities within these industry areas and develop a comprehensive whole of industry approach to sustainable training and capability building ofworkers.

We keep industry advised of training developments within our sector, including new apprenticeship and traineeship opportunities and school-based training arrangements.



Training Package Coverage

We broker effective representation on training-related matters, including the development and review of National Training Packages and curriculum to ensure qualifications and training meet industry needs. Part of our role is to monitor and review the quality of training delivery and assessment across the Training Packages within our portfolio. This includes delivery of qualifications to secondary school students.

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
